The aim of this measure is to deliver non-clinical mental health psychosocial supports to Murrumbidgee residents who have severe mental illness, are not engaged in the NDIS or receiving psychosocial supports through similar state funded programs.

Description of Activity *

Elevator Pitch: The delivery of flexible, recovery focussed, non-clinical mental health psychosocial supports to people living with severe mental illness who are not engaged in the NDIS or receiving psychosocial services through other state funded psychosocial programs.

Describe the activity

Psychosocial supports include a range of non-clinical supports with a strong recovery focus, are trauma informed and provided in a flexible manner. Service delivery includes a range of formats including individual support, place-based services, group activities and outreach supports. Psychosocial support focuses on building personal capacity and stability in areas such as: increasing daily living skills, managing social and family connections, financial management and physical wellbeing.

Aim of Activity *

The National Psychosocial Support (NPS) Service Navigation measure aims to improve the integration of local health services and make the health system more accessible for people with severe mental illness and associated psychosocial disorders.

Description of Activity *

Elevator Pitch:

The service navigator role aims to improve the integration of local health services and make the health system more accessible for people with severe mental illness and associated psychosocial disorders.

Outcomes:

- Consumers, families and carers have a better understanding of the service options available across a range of service domains.
- Consumers have increased choice in accessing a broader range of relevant health and support services to achieve recovery goals and manage their conditions on a day to day basis in the community.
- GPs, program managers and service provider staff have a better understanding of services available in their regions to support the social, mental and physical health needs of consumers with severe mental illness and promote effective multidisciplinary care.
- The development of a joint understanding of psychosocial consumer referral pathways, available supports, service gaps and emerging issues. Where there is capacity, implement strategies to mitigate identified barriers to this objective.

The Service Navigator roles will assist with developing streamlined and standardised intake and referral processes, where appropriate, for people with severe mental illness, together with their families and carers.

Services should be targeted to support existing and new clients of Commonwealth psychosocial support programs; however, NDIS participants would not be excluded from accessing support from Service Navigators
